will be of two postcards with two different images of iconic scenes in Middlebury. An explanation of the scenes will also be written. There will be a map indicating the location. It will show the town's logo with the title Welcome to Middlebury. This will be surrounded by Mountain Laurel state flowers and Ivy which symbolizes eternity, faith, commitment and loyalty. Ivy also represents devoted attachment, dedication and affection towards love, partner or friend. Adding our state bird, the Cardinal. Sue has done research on wall prep, priming and paint pricing. The Greenway Committee has approximately \$3,000.00 to put toward the project to get started. The Committee members will consider fundraising ideas at the next meeting. Phase 2 of the project will focus on the inside of the Tunnel and lighting. Trish Lindenman MOTIONED to approve Sue Healy as the artist and to start Phase 1 of the Tunnel Project; SECONDED Jennifer Mahr. Unanimous Approval.
